Giza Pyramids, Saqqara, with Boat Trip from Alexandria

Your adventure begins the moment you reach Alexandria and are received by a representative of Cairo Top Tours at your hotel. Then, you will take a comfortable transfer to Cairo, where our good and experienced tour leader will assist you and introduce you to an informative English-speaking guide. First, you will head to the ever-famous Giza Plateau, which is home to Egypt's most famous pyramids.

At Giza, you will see the mind-blowing Great Pyramid of Khufu, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, alongside the Pyramid of Khafre and the smaller Pyramid of Menkaure. Gaze at the enigmatic Sphinx standing guard over the plateau with its lion's body and human head, a representation of strength and wisdom. You will also be able to enter the Valley Temple where ancient mummification rituals took place. Climb on high to give a panoramic view of all three pyramids. Get unique access to the Pyramid of Khafre, the second-largest pyramid in Giza, and walk into its hidden corridors.

After the exploration of Giza, you will enjoy a traditional Egyptian lunch in a local restaurant before heading to Saqqara, the ancient necropolis full of history. Here is the place you can visit the great Step Pyramid of Djoser, the first monumental structure in history, along with the tombs of some nobles, which are highly carved and beautifully adorned. Your trip will go on to the Serapeum, making visible one of the fascinating religious beliefs of ancient Egypt. You can unwind while drifting on the eternal river and enjoy snapping some stunning views of the city at sunset.
