The site of Philae Temple highlights the goddess Isis through its magnificent structures and the technical prowess of the Aswan High Dam can be admired. Witness Nubian village culture and scenic Elephantine Island by sailing through the area in a classic felucca boat. Visitors who want to experience something truly extraordinary can embark on a visit to the Abu Simbel Temples which Ramses II had carved into the mountains.

The northward path along the Nile River should include visits to the Temple of Kom Ombo and the well-conserved Temple of Edfu where Horus the falcon deity is honored. Visitors can enter Luxor's open-air museum after their arrival as this destination features the expansive Karnak Temple together with Luxor Temple and the burial sites within the Valley of the Kings. Before continuing your journey to Cairo you must check out the mortuary temple of Queen Hatshepsut together with Memnon's massive statues before taking public transportation.

Travelers in Cairo get to enjoy how timeless Egyptian history exists harmoniously among contemporary city life. Bewilderment strikes visitors at the Great Pyramids of Giza along with the Sphinx mystery while they search for treasures at the Egyptian Museum which holds the sacred artifacts of King Tutankhamun. The Khan El Khalili Bazaar provides a sensory experience with its aromatic mix of spices and its glittering collection of handmade merchandise throughout the market.
