A shrine to Goddess Isis, Philae Temple symbolizes the enduring submission of Egyptian people anent history. The temple was repose to Agilika, about half a mile away from Philae Island where initially settled to evade water influx from Lake Nasser due construction of a high dam at Aswan.

Inspect the temple complex, and take it all in including the wonderful carvings, ancient texts, and impressive colonnaded halls.

Sound and Light Show: Experience the fabulous history of Philae Temple by watching a sound & light show that takes over the temple complex at night the site with vibrant lumens. Admire the mighty Aswan High Dam and be amazed at this architectural marvel that changed the face of Egyptian geography.

Philae Temple, High Dam and Unfinished Obelisk tour

Your hotel pick-up is about 7:30 AM (time will depend on the location of the hotel). In Aswan, it will be arranged a comfortable vehicle or tour bus to drive you around the sites.

Begin the day at the High Dam — a magnificent accomplishment that stops flood waters from overflowing in Egypt and generates electric power. Look out over the dam and the dam lake, referred to as Lake Nasser, which is one of the largest Artificial lakes in the world. Explore the Unfinished Obelisk at the old quarries of Aswan. Unfinished Obelisk, if ever finished, would be the largest obelisk ever constructed

Board a canoe on Lake Nasser for a leisurely trip to Philae Temple, one of Egypt's most beautiful architectural masterpieces dedicated to the goddess Isis.

The temple itself is on an island, and you will be entertained by the stunning views and route the brief boat ride.

Learn about the Philae Temple (7th century BC) while admiring cultural heritage, in particular religious significance.

Best in class the standing reliefs and inscriptions of Egyptian history

Take a tour of the temple complex, which includes Isis' main temple and the Kiosk of Trajan on the island. Maybe have lunch at a local eatery or café facing the NILE view.

In the evening after a great day, you will be driven back to your hotel.
