Itinerary

Day 1: Transfer to Luxor

Your Cairo Top Tours representative will transport you from Hurghada Hotel to Luxor for a 4-hour drive by personal car. Your representative will support your embarkation onto the cruise vessel of the Egypt Nile River followed by lunch service to start your day of Luxor sightseeing.

Toward afternoon you can begin the noteworthy day tour through Egypt to visit Luxor Temple followed by Karnak Temple with its distinctive towered system of columns.

This temple was founded by various royal leaders across different New Kingdom dynasties as a symbol of Egyptian architectural splendor. Your dinner based on traditional cuisine will be delivered on board the Nile cruise as you attend their night festival.

The travelers spend a night in Luxor while onboard the Nile cruise.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tour

Start your Luxor west bank tours with a necropolis tour at the Valley of the Kings to see rock-cut tombs containing New Kingdom royal burials which are perfectly ornamented on the inside with well-preserved wall paintings. The two stone statues known as Colossi of Memnon mark the pharaoh Amenhotep III while visiting Queen Hatshepsut Temple or El Deir El Bahari Temple which served as the 5th Pharaoh of the eighteenth ruling family. Take pleasure in the open-buffet lunch and dinner served during your Nile cruise as you sail to Edfu.

Overnight aboard your Nile cruise.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Begin your day with breakfast on board, after which a horse-drawn carriage transfer will take you to Edfu's magnificent Temple of Horus, dedicated to the falcon god. After visiting the temple, you shall embark once more and head toward Kom Ombo, where lunch will be served onboard. In the afternoon, one will visit the Kom Ombo Temple, an ancient structure dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god.

Thereafter, the journey continues toward Aswan, offering picturesque views along the Nile. Relax with a sumptuous dinner onboard as you cruise and spend a peaceful night in Aswan.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

Start the day with a wholesome breakfast and then meet your knowledgeable guide for a thrilling excursion in Aswan. The first destination is the famous Aswan High Dam, the second-largest dam in the world that is very important for power generation and flood control in Egypt. Learn about this engineering marvel and its importance to the country. After that, proceed to the Unfinished Obelisk, an enormous monument from the time of Queen Hatshepsut, which gives a hint about the magnitude of ancient Egyptian craftsmanship.

Next, proceed to Philae Temple, a stark example of Greco-Roman architecture devoted to the goddess Isis, tucked away on an island in the Nile. Learn about the temple's rich history and the ancient Egyptians' devotee-like passion towards their religious beliefs. After such an adventurous day, enjoy a delicious lunch and a dinner on board your Nile cruise, reclining in style as you prepare for an overnight in Aswan.
