Pay a visit to the magnificent mortuary temple of Queen Hatshepsut, one of Egypt's most powerful female rulers. Make a stop at the towering Colossi of Memnon: two imposing statues that have stood for over 3,000 years, guarding the mortuary temple of Amenhotep III.

Cross the Nile and continue to the Karnak Temple Complex, the huge wonder of ancient Egyptian architecture. Be in awe of its great hypostyle hall with towering columns, the sacred lake, and the exquisite carvings that reflect the grandeur of the New Kingdom era.

Conclude your day with a visit to the magnificent Luxor Temple, a place that for thousands of years has symbolized power and divinity. Stroll along the imposing colonnades and learn about its significance in ancient religious and ceremonial traditions.
