## **Day 1: Start your exciting adventure with Cairo Top Tours:**

Get ready to enjoy the warm welcome that one of Cairo Top Tours representatives will offer you upon your arrival at Cairo International Airport. He will help you facilitate all the main procedures at the airport. You will meet your tour leader, who will transfer you to one of the best hotels in Cairo in a private, comfortable, and air-conditioned car.

He will review with you the itinerary and start times of each tour. He will help you check in at the hotel to save you time to get some rest before starting your tour tomorrow.

## **Day 2: Amazing tour to the Pyramids of Giza, Memphis, Saqqara:**

You will have your first delicious breakfast in Egypt at your beautiful hotel, and then you will meet your tour guide in the hotel lobby to start your enjoyable tour. You will start by visiting one of the most important archaeological landmarks that was and still is the greatest architectural and engineering mystery that has baffled scientists until now. One of the most important recent discoveries that was reached after in-depth research by Akio Kato from the Department of Mathematics and Physics at Kanagawa University in Japan is that the pyramids have succeeded in deceiving the eyes of humans for thousands of years, that they have eight faces, not just four, and that they are concave from the top, by using the latest technology to see the pyramids from above.

You will also see the Sphinx statue, for which the University of Florida mission conducted a detailed examination of the statue, the surrounding area, and the pyramid plateau and confirmed that there are rooms and chambers underground in front of the Sphinx. The Australian explorer Robert Ballard announced that he believed that the pyramids were built above a complex of tunnels and passages under the Sphinx, and it is believed that the stones used in building the pyramids were taken from these passages and chambers. You will visit the Valley of the Temple dedicated to King Khafre, which is a temple built of extremely hard granite, connected to the pyramid by a bridge. Inside it are several impressive statues of King Khafre, knowing that these statues are built of diorite stones that were brought from a distant quarry in the Nubian desert.

You will visit the dazzling Saqqara, which the famous archaeologist Dr. Zahi Hawass said was the cemetery of the capital Memphis is considered an open book that tells the story of ancient Egyptian civilization through different eras. It is the only cemetery in Egypt and the world that includes tombs from the beginning of Egyptian history until its end, and it also has antiquities from the Greek and Roman eras, as well as tombs full of beautiful and unique colored engravings and views, such as the amazing tombs of the nobles. You will also see the Step Pyramid of Djoser, which contains the burial chamber, which was built of granite stones. The burial chamber is surrounded by 4 corridors; it is believed that they were dedicated to the king's funerary equipment. Inside the pyramid there are also exhibition halls; they are halls lined with beautiful blue ceramic tiles, and the sacred Apis bulls were buried in them, especially in the Serapeum exhibition hall. You will also visit the Pyramid of Teti, where a series of beautiful and precise inscriptions were engraved on the walls of the burial chamber, many of which are identical to those found in the impressive Pyramid of Unas. These inscriptions were written in smaller letters and signs than those found in the Pyramid of Unas.

You will visit the famous city of Memphis, which has impressed many creators. It was mentioned by Homer, the author of the famous epics Iliad and Odyssey, and the historians Ibn Abd al-Hakam al-Qurashi, al-Yaqubi, and Jamal al-Din al-Afghani immortalized it in their writings. Alexander the Great also made a pilgrimage to it. This city included a collection of palaces, one for King Merneptah and the other for King Apries of the 26th Dynasty. The ruins of the city still include that huge statue carved from pink granite, which is a masterpiece of beauty and sculpture, in addition to a group of standing statues bearing the name of Ramses II. It also includes the largest statue of the Sphinx after the famous Giza statue, which is made of alabaster and dates back to the New Kingdom, in addition to a well-known plaque from the era of King Apries.

### **Day 3: Exploration trip in the Egyptian Museum and Coptic and Islamic Cairo:**

You cannot visit Egypt without visiting the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir, which is one of the most important and largest museums in the Middle East. So after enjoying your delicious breakfast, you will meet your

professional tour guide to start your tour. We will take you to Tahrir Square to see the famous Egyptian Museum, which is distinguished not only by the fact that it includes a huge number of rare artifacts but also by its impressive and precise design. In 1895, the first international competition was organized to choose the architect of the Egyptian Museum building. The brilliant French engineer Marcel Dourgnon was then chosen to design it. On April 1, 1897, the first foundation stone for the museum was laid by the Italian company Giuseppe Garozzo and Francesco Zafrani. The museum was later opened in 1902 by Khedive Abbas Hilmi II, becoming a unique historical landmark in the center of Cairo until now.

You will also visit the Citadel of Salah El Din, which is world-famous for being used to protect Egypt for a long time. It was built by Salah El Din to protect Egypt from the fierce attacks of the Crusaders and then became the official seat of government during the reign of Sultan Al-Kamil bin Al-Adil. The British forces tried to occupy the citadel to use it as a fortress against the Egyptians, but the Egyptian forces were able to expel the British from it. After that, it was the headquarters of the Egyptian army, and then it was reopened to the public to serve as an important archaeological and historical landmark that can be visited after it was classified as part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will visit the Mosque of Muhammad Ali. The most important feature of this dazzling and unique mosque from all the historical mosques in Cairo, in addition to its charming architectural design, is the use of a precious type of marble known as alabaster to cover its interior and exterior walls, which is why it is sometimes known as the Alabaster Mosque. It is also distinguished by two famous minarets, the highest in Egypt. You will also see inside the beautiful ancient clock tower, which contains a clock that was given to Muhammad Ali Pasha by the famous French King Louis Philippe, and you will also be amazed by the decorated marble ablution dome.

Then we will move on to explore the Coptic Cairo area. You will be amazed to see the oldest and most beautiful ancient churches in the Middle East. You will visit the famous Hanging Church, which was called in the Middle Ages "the Church of the Stairs" because there are about 23 steps at its entrance to ascend to the church. It was also known as "the Church of the Column," and this name was given at the time of the miracle of moving the Muqattam Mountain during the reign of the Fatimid Caliph Al-Muizz li-Din Allah when the Virgin Mary appeared to Anba Abraam on a column inside the Hanging Church to guide him and strengthen his faith.

You will also visit the Church of Abu Serga, which is also known as the Church of the Cave. This church is also distinguished by the presence of an ancient holy water well from which Christ drank, and on its opening, there is currently a glass door through which visitors can look into the well. The cave is divided into three sections separated by stone columns and is 6 meters long and 4.5 meters wide. The cave is at least 6 meters lower than the church roof. You will see the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which was originally a Coptic church but was sold to a member of the Jewish community due to the high taxes imposed on the Christians during this period. The site originally included two synagogues; the first was the Iraqi Synagogue, which was affiliated with the Jews of Iraqi origin, and the second was the Levantine Synagogue for the Jews of Palestinian origin. The Ben Ezra Synagogue is considered to be what remains of the "Levantine," while the Iraqi Synagogue, according to the book and documents, has no trace today.

At the end of the tour, you will visit the Khan El Khalili market, which was originally built on the site of a medieval shrine. It has been an important commercial center for local and international merchants since the 14th century. It is the most famous and beautiful market in Egypt. It is also located near the Hussein Mosque, the Ghouri Agency, and the famous Al-Azhar Market.
