Day 1: Arrival to Cairo during Easter

When you reach Cairo International Airport, your designated English-speaking tour guide will help you with orientation. A private air-conditioned transport will bring you to your hotel during your pleasant transit from the airport.

The representative will provide a welcome drink as they perform the check-in process at the hotel. The representative will explain your schedule and verify the collection times for your Easter tours of Cairo Short Break during the appointment.

Overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids and Sakkara Tour

Have breakfast in your Cairo hotel accommodations before a tour guide leads you on a Cairo Day Tour experience.

The Giza Plateau serves as your initial destination to observe the Great Pyramid, which King Khufu built in 2560 BCE. Your tour includes visits to these three important nearby structures: the Khafre pyramid and the Menkaure pyramid, in addition to the Great Sphinx.

Your tour now continues to Saqqara, where you can admire the Step Pyramid, which Imhotep built for King Djoser, constituting the world's first stone construction. Moving on, we will stop at the Pyramid of Teti, followed by a visit to explore the noble tombs, which display vibrant illustrations showing ancient Egyptian activities.

During the afternoon, spend your time eating at a local dining establishment before you make a trip to Memphis, where the ancient capital used to be situated.

Your expedition ends with a hotel lodging before continuing your visit in Cairo.

Day 3 : Cairo Tours

Host your first encounter of the Egypt Day Tour by eating breakfast at your Cairo hotel. The expert guide who joins you on the tour will reveal the ancient treasures from King Tutankhamun at the Egyptian Museum alongside its other historical exhibits.

The Citadel of Saladin contains the impressive Mohamed Ali Mosque and priceless panoramic views from its location.

Old Cairo stands before you to discover the Hanging Church and the Church of St. Sergius which functioned as Holy Family sanctuary. At Ben Ezra Synagogue you will find a location which relates to the events surrounding Moses' life.

A walk through Islamic Cairo's bustling streets follows lunch as you see historic city walls and gates. The experience ends with tea prepared at a traditional café located inside Khan El Khalili which holds status as Cairo's most famed bazaar.

You will rest for the night at your hotel in Cairo after this day's activities.
