Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Nile Cruise Dinner

When you arrive at <u>Cairo international airport</u> our representative willaccompany you to the hotel in Cairo and assist you with the check-in procedures and revise your 6 Days Cairo and Hurghada Easter Tours itinerary. Upon arrival the hotel you will be served a welcome drink.

An optional <u>Cairo Nile dinner cruise</u> is available this night to have a delightful dinner buffet while sailing the Nile River aboard a Nile cruise boat sailing for 1 hour, a nice oriental show (belly dancing) and Tanoura dance show will entertain you during your Nile cruise dinner in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids, Dahshur, Memphis

After enjoying your breakfast, you'll be able to explore the history of the great pyramid builders and more on your Cairo day tour to Giza Pyramids, Dahshur, and Memphis with our tour guide.

Today, you can begin your Cairo day tours by taking the <u>Giza Pyramids tour</u>. You'll be surprised by how large these impressive ancient Egyptian structures are, built over 4500 years ago by some of the most successful ancient Egyptian kings and rulers.

The Great Pyramid of King Cheops is a beautiful example of the skill and dedication of ancient builders. It is a testimony to their incredible craftsmanship and engineering skills. This pyramid was constructed by more than 2.3 million blocks of limestone to serve as the eternal home from where he would rise to the heavens, the building stood at a height of 146 meters with 230 meters long on each side.

Passing by the high plateau to get a scenic view of the 3 pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus.

Chephren, the son of Cheops, built his pyramid slightly smaller than his father, with a height of 136 meters. Some remains of the outer casing are still at the top.

See the Great Sphinx in Giza, which is a statue of a man-headed lion that is thought to have been built by King Chephren himself. Enter the Valley Temple where the mummification process of the king took place as part of the burial process.

Resume your tours of Cairo by moving to the site of the ancient city of Memphis, now known as Mit Rahina, and see the open-air museum with the second-biggest sphinx made out of alabaster and the colossal statue of King Ramses II, who was the most powerful kings during the new kingdom.

Then we will be heading to <u>Dahshur</u> archaeological site to see the <u>Bent Pyramid</u> and the Red Pyramid—two of four pyramids that were constructed for King <u>Snefru</u>, founder of the <u>4th dynasty</u> and the father of King Cheops. The Bent Pyramid still retains a big percentage of the outer casing material, making it one of the most unique pyramids in Egypt. The <u>Red Pyramid</u> is recognized for the reddish color of the limestone blocks used in the structure and is considered the 1st perfect-shaped pyramid in the history of Egypt.

You'll enjoy a delicious lunch in a top-rated restaurant overlooking the pyramids of Giza before being transferred back to your hotel.

Day 3: Fly to Hurghada, Optional Hurghada Bedouin Desert Safari By Jeep

You will have a tasty breakfast and after that, you will be transferred to Cairo airport to have a flight to Hurghada where you will meet our representative there who will transfer you to the hotel and help you with all the check-in procedures. Stay the rest of the day at leisure enjoying the pool and the night show or you can have an optional Hurghada Bedouin Safari by Jeep during sunset or any other options from our Hurghada excursions.

Enjoy your lunch in a good quality restaurant. After that, we will resume Cairo day tours by the Egyptian Museum tour, and see the most ancient artifacts inside the Egyptian Museum in Cairo which was opened to the public in 1902 to house the biggest collection of ancient artifacts.

Finally, you will be transferred to the oldest market in Cairo for an amazing shopping experience in the Khan El Khalili bazaar.

You will be transferred to the hotel for check-in and overnight in Cairo.
