Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Day 02: The Great Pyramid, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo

After enjoying your breakfast, you'll join one of our fascinating Cairo day tours and visit the Giza pyramids.

The great pyramid of Cheops and the pyramid of Chephren as well as the smallest royal pyramid in Giza were built for the burial of King Mycerinus, one of the lastest kings of the <u>fourth dynasty</u> who ruled Egypt before his son King Shepseskaf.

With a specialist Egyptologist by your side, you'll learn all about the Sphinx and the historical details surrounding it. Then you'll visit the Valley Temple, also known as the mummification temple of king Chephren. This impressive structure was built from Aswan granite quarries and paved with white alabaster.

Your tour guide and personal driver will take you on a wonderful tour of the Egyptian Museum, where you'll be delightfully impressed by the treasures of Tutankhamun.

We'll stop for lunch at a local restaurant, and then we'll continue our tour of Coptic Cairo to see the old churches and synagogues. First, we'll visit the Hanging Church, built above the ruins of an ancient Roman fortress of Babylon. Then, we'll visit the Cavern Church of Abu Serga, where the holy family took shelter for few months during the holy family journey to Egypt. Finally, we'll visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue, the oldest Jewish temple in Egypt.

Back to the hotel and overnight.

Day 03: Cairo to Aswan By Air

After checking out you will be moved by our representative to Cairo International Airport which needs an hour drive from Giza.

you will catch your flight to Aswan which is a 1-hour flight. When you reach Aswan you will be met and transferred to embark on your 5 stars Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor, which is one of the best recommended Egypt Nile River Cruises.

Your accredited tour guide and driver will pick up you in the afternoon to enjoy sailing on the <u>River Nile</u> by Felucca around <u>Kitchener's Island</u> and Agha Khan Mausoleum. Afternoon Tea.

Enjoy your open-buffet dinner which will be served aboard the boat and you will enjoy watching the Nubian Folkloric show.

Day 04 : Aswan Tours, Kom Ombo Temple, Sail to Edfu

you will enjoy your breakfast on board the cruise and after finishing that you will start your tour in Aswan to see one of the most outstanding modern projects that are completely associated to raise up Egyptian income, it's the famous Aswan High Dam, the Unfinished Obelisk, which was built by Queen Hatshepsut and described as one of the most important monuments. Visit the Temple of Philae, where you can see the main temple dedicated to the worship of Goddess Isis, mother of Horus. See the two granite lions guard the entrance of the temple; they are of the late Roman era and reflect Byzantine influence.

Transfer back to the Nile cruise boat that will start sailing towards Kom Ombo, an open-buffet lunch during the sailing will be served aboard your luxurious boat. Upon arrival, you will meet your private tour guide to enjoy your astonishing tour to the <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, the double temple erected during the Ptolemaic dynasty and dedicated to God Sobek the crocodile evil spirit according to ancient Egyptian religion, and God Horus. Then the Nile Cruise boat will be sailing to Edfu. enjoy your afternoon tea while sailing, Captain's welcome cocktail.

Dinner will be served aboard the cruise and disco music in the lounge bar for tonight's entertainment. Overnight on board at Edfu.

On its head is the Double Crown of Upper and Lower Egypt. after you learn all the information about Edfu you will be back to the Nile Cruise ship and you will start sailing to Luxor. Your lunch will be served on board and the afternoon tea.

In the evening your high-quality dinner is included onboard the ship, then you will enjoy a wonderful traditional Galabya party.
