Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

The building was constructed from the beginning of the Middle Kingdom to the Graeco-Roman era by many Egyptian kings.

Also, you will visit the monuments of the West bank of the Nile, <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u> in Deir Al-Bahary, <u>The</u> Valley of kings, and the Colossi of Memnon.

After that, you will be transferred to Hurghada by land for about 3 hours drive and then overnight in your Hurghada hotel.
