Day 1: Arrive to Luxor - Check-in - East Bank Tours

Continue to visit [Karnak Temple](#) dedicated to Gods [Amun Re](#), [Mut](#), and Khonsu and considered a complex of many temples, kiosks, and pylons built by more than a pharaoh in different eras. Day 2: Luxor West Bank Excursions - Sail to Esna

You will have a delicious breakfast aboard the MS Movenpick Royal Lily Nile cruise, then our guide will be ready at the lobby waiting for you to begin your daily sightseeing tours in Luxor. Today's excursion will cover one of the most important sites in Egypt which is also announced by UNESCO, the [Luxor West Bank tours](#).

Visit the [Valley of the Kings](#), the great Necropolis of Millions of Years of Pharaohs which has 63 magnificent royal tombs, situated on the ancient site of Thebes, the capital of Ancient Egypt. After that, you will visit the [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#) who was the second historically confirmed female pharaoh, her mortuary temple is dedicated to [Amon-Ra](#), the sun god as well as [the Colossi of Memnon](#). Enjoy lunch while sailing to Esna and spend the evening celebrating and having fun after gourmet dinner on board.

Day 3: Edfu Temple - Kom Ombo Temple and arrival to from Luxor to Aswan

On the third day of your Egypt Christmas Tours, visit [Edfu Temple](#) after taking your tasty breakfast, this temple is built during the Ptolemaic period, and it is dedicated to the god of heaven and the protector of kingship, [God Horus](#), one of the most popular deities who appears prominently in the ancient Egyptian mythology and legends and the son of [Osiris](#) and Goddess [Isis](#). Then your personal guide will take you back to the cruise ship to enjoy a wholesome lunch before the Nile cruise leaves for Kom Ombo, on arrival you will meet your guide in the lobby and you will start walking to the amazing Temple of [Kom Ombo](#) dedicated to [Sobek](#) the crocodile god, and Horemakhet the falcon-headed god. Enjoy a lovely dinner in the main restaurant followed by evening entertainment.

Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

You will have a tasty breakfast while sailing to Aswan then visit [the High Dam](#) which was built across the Nile in Aswan to produce electric power and control the floods in Egypt. After that, visit [the Unfinished Obelisk](#) and have a motorboat ride to get to Phiale, which captured the imagination of infinite travelers to Egypt from early times. It was famed for its beauty and was known as the 'Pearl of Egypt'. Continue [Aswan day tours](#) to see the [Philae Temple](#) which was built in the honor of [Goddess Isis](#). Enjoy dinner and a folkloric show overnight in Aswan.
