#### Day 1 : Luxor East Bank

our representative will meet you at the airport/hotel to welcome you then you will be transferred to embark board the nile cruise to start your amazing vacation, you will visit <u>Luxor temple</u> was built with sandstone from the Gebel el-Silsila, which was used for the construction for monuments in Upper Egypt as well as in the past and current restoration works, is a large Ancient Egyptian temple complex located on the east bank, It was one of the two primary temples on the east bank,

the other being Karnak temple which dedicated to the Theban triad of Amun, Mut, and Khonsu. The Hypostyle hall, at 54,000 square feet (16,459 meters) and featuring 134 columns, is still the largest room of any religious building in the world. In addition to the main sanctuary there are several smaller temples and a vast sacred lake -423 feet by 252 feet (129 by 77 meters).

### Day 2: Luxor West bank

after having your breakfast you will visit a largest place which contains a large number of the mummies of kings and queens is the valley of the kings, its main purpose was to secure the royal tombs for the pharaohs of the new kingdom. The pyramids was the traditional burials for the royals and priests but it was exposed to robbery and occupation, especially during the Hyksos invasion.

move to visit <u>El-dier elbahari</u> which was built by the queen of Hatshepsut, the upper terrace of Hatshepsut's temple has a forefront portico with two rows of columns. The external row is made of square columns decorated with colossal osiride statues of the queen.

then you will visit the Clossai of Memnon are two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III, which stand at the front of the ruined Mortuary Temple of Amenhotep III, the largest temple in the Theban Necropolis.

Otional (<u>hot air balloon ride</u>) Get amazing view overlooking one of the world's most attraction-packed cities during this hot air balloon ride over Luxor. See ancient temples like the Statue of Thebes from above, illuminated by the early morning sun.

## Day 3: Kom ombo & Edfu temples

in the morning you will visit the temple of kom ombo is known for its unique double temple of the Ptolemaic and Roman periods, which is dedicated to Sebek (Suchos), the crocodile god, and to Horus, the falconheaded god, Kom Ombo is an agricultural town in Egypt famous for the Temple of Kom Ombo.

then, visit the Temple of Edfu, the large Ptolemaic period Temple of Horus at Edfu is the best-preserved ancient temple structure in Egypt, Edfu is best known as agricultural town, its main products being sugar cane and pottery. It was built during the reign of Ptolemy.

### **Day 4: Aswan Temples**

after you take your breakfast you will move to visit Aswan Attractions, the high dam is the main electricity to the country and it protects the country from floods, was completed in 1970 (and formally inaugurated in January 1971). The dam, is 364 feet (111 meters) high, with a crest length of 12,562 feet (3,830 meters) and a volume of 57,940,000 cubic yards.

then you will explore the Philae temple that was Built during (Egypt's Greco-Roman Period), and is dedicated to Isis, Osiris, and Horus. The temple walls contain scenes from Egyptian mythology.

move to see the Unfinished Obelisk in Aswan is one of the most popular sites in Aswan and the most important archaeological finds in Egypt, the unfinished obelisk provides immense insight into stone masonry employed by the ancient Egyptians

optional (<u>Abu Simbel Tour</u>) enjoy visiting the two massive rock temples at <u>Abu Simbel</u> a village in Nubia, The complex is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site known as the "Nubian Monuments"
