Itinerary

Day 1: Wednesday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

When you arrive at <u>Aswan Airport</u>, a Cairo Top Tours tour manager will greet you and transfer you to your Egypt Nile River Cruise, the MS Al Jamila Nile cruise.

Lunch is served aboard the cruise ship. Start your tours in Aswan which is the southernmost city in Egypt. It is located in the first Nile waterfall, almost a thousand kilometers away from Cairo. Relish your <u>Aswan day tours</u> to <u>the high dam</u>, which is a very important project in our modern history not less significant than the <u>Suez Canal</u>, providing electricity to most of Egypt's villages for the first time by regulating the course of the river.

Then you will be transported to see the relocated temple known as the Temple of Philae which was built to honor the Goddess Isis, it was built in the Greco-Roman style. you will learn about the myth of Isis and Horus and realize that the damage to some of the figures of the ancient Egyptian gods took place by early Christians who attempted to raise the pagan representation from their newly claimed churches. Continue Aswan excursions to the granite quarries to see the Unfinished Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut.

Return to the boat which is going to sail after we finished our Egypt Day Tours. to enjoy your afternoon tea, and later it will be time for the captain's welcome cocktail, and in the evening you will have a delicious dinner aboard your Nile cruise Aswan to Luxor. Enjoy the Nubian Show and overnight aboard your Nile cruise ship in Aswan.

Day 2: Thursday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

On the second day, enjoy your tasty breakfast aboard the cruise boat then start your tour to Kom Ombo and visit the magnificent Kom Ombo Temple which was established for the worship of the two gods Sobek and Haeroris Kom Ombo, Subsequently, since the inhabitants did not like to have a divinity that represented evil, they added another god to the cult, Haroeris (Horus the Elder). Then you will sail to Edfu after you will enjoy your lunch aboard the Nile cruise boat then continue to see the famous temple of the falcon Horus who avenged the killing of his father by his uncle, Edfu Temple tour will take you about 2 hours and you will return to the Nile cruise to get prepared for dinner aboard the cruise boat while enjoying the view .after that you will sail to Esna then enjoy watching an Egyptian Galabeya Party.

Overnight in Esna.

Day 3: Friday - Luxor West Bank Tours

Enjoy your breakfast aboard the cruise boat while sailing to Luxor, then you will proceed to start <u>Luxor day tours</u> and specifically <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u> to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> and Queens, it was part of the ancient city of Thebes and was the burial site of almost all the pharaohs of the eighteenth, nineteenth, and twentieth ruling families of <u>the new kingdom</u> during <u>ancient Egypt history</u>, continue <u>Luxor excursions</u> to see the temple of Queen Hatshepsut known as El-Deir El Bahari Temple and the <u>Colossi Memnon</u> that was built hugely as the representation of King <u>Amenhotep III</u>, then you will go back and have lunch aboard the vessel then proceed to enjoy an afternoon tea after you are done you will enjoy the weather and the view then enjoy your dinner aboard the cruise boat while watching a belly dance show

spending the night in Luxor

Day 4: Saturday - Disembarkation - Luxor East Bank Tours

After finishing Luxor Sightseeing tours, you will be transferred to the airport or the train station for your final departure.
