### Day 1 - Aswan City Tour

Upon your arrival to Aswan, our tour guide will meet and greet you to transfer you by an air-conditioned vehicle into Steam Ship Sudan Nile Cruise .to relax and enjoy the sun while having your open buffet lunch on the deck. In the afternoon, you will visit [Aswan High Dam](#) which was rebuilt again on [Agilika Island](#) after the building of the High Dam irrigational system, passing by the [Unfinished Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut](#)

. then, you will explore [the magnificent temple of Philae](#), which was built during the Greco-Roman period. You have the chance to have a Felucca Trip around [Kitchener](#) and to walk through the Nubian colorful markets of Aswan, Before dining on board.

## Day 2- Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples

In the morning, you will have your breakfast meal, before departing early to visit the magnificent temple [Kom Ombo](#) . Then, you will return back to your Steam Ship Sudan Nile Cruise to relax and have your Lunch while enjoying the landscape of Aswan. In the afternoon, you will be guided to explore [Edfu Temples](#) .
