Itinerary

Day 1: Luxor east bank

Cairo's top tour Representative will meet you at Cairo Airport or your hotel in Giza/Cairo to welcome you then you will be transferred to Luxor by taking your flight and upon arrival, you will meet our professional guide and asset you to check in on **the MS Grand Princess Nile Cruise Egypt**, then you will start your beauty tour by visiting

the Luxor temple which was largely built by the New Kingdom pharaohs Amenhotep III (1390-1352 BC) and Ramses II (1279-1213 BC).

you will move to see <u>the Karnak temple</u> the Great Temple of Amon at Karnak, This great national monument of Egypt has no equal, most of the structures were built in honor of Amon-Ra, his consort Mut and son Khonsu.

optional the sound and light show in Karnak temple.

Day 2: Luxor West bank

in the morning, you will move to discover the sites on Luxor west bank including the temple of Hatshepsut known as <u>el-dier el-Bahari</u> was built by snnmut here famous engineer. and visit <u>the valley</u> <u>of the kings</u> which had been the site of royal burials from the First Intermediate Period (2181–2055 BC).

and we will transfer you to see the largest statues of king Amenhotep ||| which at its height was the most lavish temple in Egypt known as <u>the colossal of Memnon</u>.

Day 3: Kom Ombo and Edfu temples

after taking your delicious breakfast aboard **the MS Grand Princess Nile Cruise Egypt** you will visit <u>the Kom Ombo temple</u> is unique in Egypt as a double temple - dedicated to two deities, Sobek and Horus.

then move to see <u>the Edfu temple</u> the Temple of Horus, the temple date back to the Ptolemaic times and is considered to be the best-preserved temple in Egypt.

Party at night aboard the Nile cruise.

Day 4: the attractions of Aswan

After having your breakfast in the morning you will begin the Aswan tour from visit <u>the Philae</u> <u>temple</u> an island in the reservoir of the Aswan Low Dam, downstream of the Aswan Dam and Lake Nasser.

then you will see <u>the high dam</u> which provides irrigation and electricity for the whole of Egypt, which was built to protect the country and control the Nile River's annual floods.

and explore <u>the unfinished obelisk</u> the largest known ancient obelisk in Aswan during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut.
