Day 1: Arrive Luxor/ Nile Cruise Sights

then visit the Unfinished Obelisk When creating the vast pyramids of Egypt throughout the old kingdom of Egypt's history, as well as the large temples, enormous pillars, and obelisks, notably during the new kingdom, ancient Egyptians used to cut and transport granite from the granite quarries.

and the magnificent Philae Temple before spending the night in Aswan on a Nile cruise ship and visiting the Botanical Garden.
