Day 1: Aswan attractions tour

Philae temple

This temple was made for the gods <u>Isis</u> and <u>Osiris</u> and it has their story with their son <u>god Hours</u> on its walls all written.

it is the most visited attraction in Kom Ombo city, as, its site is what makes it special as it is in the middle of the water between Aswan and Edfu city.

The Temple of Edfu or the Temple of Horus in Edfu is the second largest temple in ancient Egypt, after Karnak, and it represents one of the last attempts of the Ptolemies to build temples in the style of their ancestors in grandeur and grandeur. It took about 180 years to build the Temple of Horus.

.Day 4: Sail to Luxor

The Valley of kings.

The number of tombs discovered in the Valley of the Kings is about 63, including royal and non-royal. The Valley of the Kings was known in the past as "the great royal funeral city for millions of years of the life, strength, and health of the pharaoh in the west of Thebes."

the colossi of Memnon.

The Colossi of Memnon, known locally as (Kolsat or Salamat), are two colossal statues, built around 1350 BC. located west of the Nile River.

then on the east bank of Luxor visit the

Karnak temple.

Karnak Temple was named after the Islamic conquest of Egypt because the word "Karnak" means a fortress or a fortified place. The entrance to the temple is the "road of rams" filled with statues of an animal that was a symbol of strength for the pharaohs.

Luxor temple

The entrance to the Luxor Temple is the first tower, 24 meters high. It was built by <u>Ramses II</u> and the tower was decorated with scenes of Ramesses' military victories (particularly the Battle of Kadesh); The victories of the pharaohs were also recorded at a later time, especially the victories of the 25th dynasty (Nubian dynasty).
