Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Cairo

In order to assist you with the arrival processes and transport you in a private vehicle to begin your great Egypt tour, the <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> leader is waiting for you inside <u>Cairo International Airport</u>. During the time of the ancient Egyptians, it was obtained from the Nile River.
