Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo airport

Inside <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will greet you with a signboard bearing your name and the <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> emblem. You will be driven to the Cairo hotel from the airport in a stylish vehicle. The Cairo Top Tours representative will meet with you after assisting you quickly check into the hotel to go over your itinerary and provide you with all of the pick-up times for your excursions in Cairo while you are on

vacation in Egypt. Cairo at sunset on the first day of the family vacations There is a warm drink at your disposal.

Day2- Tour to Giza Pyramids, , Dahshour

After breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up and take you to the spectacular <u>Giza pyramids</u>. You can embark on an expedition and explore the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, while you're there in addition to admiring it. <u>The great Sphinx</u> that guards the Pyramids will then emerge. After that, we change buses to travel to the Dahshour pyramids. Visit the Red and Bent Pyramids at Dahshour, built by King Sinfru, the father of Cheops. Learn about the mistakes that the Egyptians made when building the pyramids.

After that, eat lunch nearby before returning to your accommodation.

Day3 - Tour To National Museum Of Egyptian Civilization & Sultan Hassan mosque

We will collect you up from your hotel and have our tour guide wait for you in an air-conditioned car to start your day off well. Your next trip will be the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization (NEMC). It is recognised as the first museum in the world to offer a comprehensive picture of the Egyptian Civilization throughout its history, from prehistory to the present.

In order to provide visitors a taste of Egyptian civilisation throughout the years, starting with predynastic and ancient Egypt, the NMEC has a variety of items on display.

After that, we'll move on to Citadel Square. We'll visit the Sultan Hassan Mosque, a magnificent Mamluke building constructed in 1359. The Giza pyramids are a symbol of ancient pharaonic Egypt, just as the El-Rifai mosque (1912), with its distinctive style and spectacular prayer hall decorations, and Sultan Hassan mosque are of old Islamic Egypt.

At the end of the day, a driver will drive you back to your hotel!

Day4-Boarding

At 10 a.m., our local personnel will meet and help you at the Luxor airport before you transfer to the Nile Cruise. Before lunch, boarding. Lunch served aboard. Visit the Luxor Temple and the <u>Karnak Temple</u>. go to the <u>Luxor Temple</u> to see the granite statues of Ramses the Great in its courtyard

Travel to Karnak, which has a number of temples constructed during various eras, via carriage or bus. Visit the Unfinished Propylon, the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 enormous columns, the Obelisks of Queen Hatshepsut and Tutomosis III, the Temple of Amon with its papyrus and lotus decorations, the Granite Scarbeus of Amenophis III, and the Sacred Lake starting by the Avenue of Sphinxes. Sunday tea. Belly Dance performance and dinner aboard. Luxor overnight on board.

Day5-The West Bank Sail to Esna.

Onboard breakfast followed by tours <u>The Valley of the Kings</u>, the Colossi of Memnon, and <u>the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u> at El Deir El Bahari are all on the West Bank. excursion to the Valley of Kings; see the temple of Deir El Bahari and the tombs of numerous dynasties.

Stop at the Colossi of Memnon, two enormous statues of Amenophis III sitting and facing the Nile, on the way back.

Afterward, go to the Queen Hatshepsut Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut. The temple at Deir el-Bahari on the west bank of the Nile close to the Valley of the Kings was built for the Eighteenth Dynasty pharaoh Hatshepsut, who passed away in 1458 BC. Lunch served aboard. Navigate to Esna. Tea in the afternoon Disco Night. A Night on the Boat

Day6- Edfu. Sail to Kom Ombo

Horus Temple a meal served on board. Visit the Edfu Temple of Horus. The Temple of Horus is the most well-known structure at Tell Edfu and is devoted to the god Horus of Behedet, lord of Edfu. It is the outstanding example of a Ptolemaic temple structure in Egypt because of its completeness and condition of preservation. The <u>edfu temple</u>, which is roughly 140m long and covers an area of 7000m2, is oriented from south to north.

Lunch served aboard. Visit the temple in Kom Ombo that is shared by the two gods Sobek and Haroeris. The Kom Ombo Temple. The <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, which is devoted to Sobek and Horus the Elder, includes two similar entrances, hypostyle halls, and sanctuaries. The symmetry of the temple's design pays homage to the two gods' fabled relationship. Evening tea. Dinner on board and a Galabya celebration Spend the night at sea in Kom Ombo.

Day7- Sail to Aswan arrival Aswan

on-board breakfast and sailing to Aswan and arriving there Aswan's <u>High Dam</u> is a must-see. A rock-fill dam called High Dam is situated at the northern boundary between Sudan and Egypt. The River Nile feeds the dam, and the reservoir creates Lake Nasser. The project's construction started in 1960 and was finished in 1968. It was formally opened in 1971.

<u>The Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which is the largest ancient obelisk that is known to exist, is situated in the northern section of the ancient Egyptian stone quarries near Aswan (Assuan), Egypt. According to archaeologists, Hatshepsut, a female pharaoh, authorised its construction. Modern engineers doubt that the Dynastic Egyptians could have completed this task, nevertheless.

The <u>Temple of Philae</u>, which is dedicated to the goddess Isis, is situated in a stunning landscape that was recreated after the temple was moved by UNESCO since the Aswan Dam construction threatened its original location. Lunch served aboard. Around Kitchener's Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum, sail the Nile by

felucca. Evening tea. Meal served aboard. Aswan, spend the night.

Day8- Disembarkation

a meal served on board. Disembarkation and transportation to the airport in Aswan

Day9-Day use in Fayoum

To begin your day's journey to Fayoum, a knowledgeable tour guide from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo. From there, you can begin your visits.pyramid of Lahoun

The 48-meter-long pyramid is located in the Fayoum Governorate. The pyramid's centre core is made completely of granite chunks and is constructed on top of a tall hill. There are passages that lead to the chamber where King Senusret II was interred beneath the pyramid.

The Pyramid of Hawara wich was One of Egypt's pyramids is the Hawara pyramid. It was constructed in the town of Hawara, 9 kilometres southeast of the city of Faiyum, by Egyptian King Amenemhat III.

It is constructed out of limestone-coated bricks.

Museum Kom Oshim: Visitors to the museum can read the identifying panels for each exhibit item, study the artefacts that are on display, and enjoy a guided tour. The most notable archaeological relics, sculptures, and artefacts on display in Kom Oshim Museum include a collection of mummy portraits from the Ptolemaic colony of Karanis that were discovered in Fayoum.

You'll then sayour a delectable supper in an Asian restaurant.

After that, sail down the vast Nile River in a felucca.

After that, we will end our service and drive you to the drop-off point.

Day 10: From Cairo to Bahariya Oasis / White Desert

At 6:30 AM, your tour guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo using a sign with your name on it and take you 350 km (about 4 hours) south-west to the Bahariya Oasis. Once you arrive in Bahariya, change your car to a 44 and begin your day with lunch before visiting "Al-Marsous Mountain," one of the Black Desert's most famous mountains. It is a volcanic crater that is entirely covered in jasper from the eruption.

next proceed to the Bedouin village to witness <u>Crystal Mountain</u> and the Valley of Agabat's Cold Sulfur Water Well. It is a mountain full of diverse crystals, with more than 12 different varieties of crystal, making it one of the rarest mountains in the world.

In the Great Sand Sea, sandboarding Near Siwa, surf the enormous dunes of the Great Sand Sea. Considered to be the best dune surfing spot in the world, the desert has exceptionally smooth, steep dunes that reach heights of 140 metres. The most well-known desert destination in Egypt is the White Desert National Park, and for good reason. Keep driving there. No other desert in the world has as many bizarre and stunning wind-carved rock formations shaped like enormous mushrooms, chickens, rabbits, or pebbles. Return to the Al Haiz campground for an overnight stay (sleep in tent).

Day11 - Bahariya Oasis / Cairo

After breakfast at the camping, visit Siwa hot sulphur springs. Take a shower in a hotel, then eat lunch at the Bahariya oasis before returning to Cairo around 5:00 p.m. breakfast and lunch

Day 12- Cairo to Sokhna

Be prepared for an interesting vacation because the Red Sea and the city of El Ain El Sokhna are both a day's journey from Cairo.

A representative of Cairo Top Tours will meet you and drive you to El Ein El Sokhna.
