Day 1 Dubai

Arrival in Dubai, we welcome you and help you transfer your luggage to the car and take you safely to your hotel.

You will walk from the ship to the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>. Return to the boat, and sail to Edfu before having lunch on board. Then visit Edfu Temple by horse and cart, lunch and dinner.

Day 8 Luxor (B, L, D)

Optional hot air balloon ride - cross to the West Bank in Luxor to visit the Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut's funerary temple and the two statues of Memnon. Return to the cruise for lunch and dinner

Cross to the east bank of the Nile to see the temples of Karnak and Luxor. <u>The Luxor Temple</u> was built to worship the god Amun-Ra. Karnak temples. Transfer to <u>Luxor Airport</u> for your flight to Cairo.

Day 10 Cairo/Departure (Breakfast)

After breakfast, check out of the hotel to transfer to Cairo Airport for your flight home
