Day1: Saying hi from Tanzania

When you arrive at Kilimanjaro Airport, our representative will meet you and take you to your hotel so you can unwind after your journey.

Day2: A visit to Lake Manyara National Park

Get together in Arusha. Following lunch, travel to Lake Manyara, a soda lake in the Rift Valley, to start your Tanzania Safari Tour. Take a safari drive in Lake Manyara National Park, the lions' home. In addition to the various kinds of savanna, swamp, and jungle, there is also an extensive variety of wildlife, including gazelles,

hippos, giraffes, zebras, elephants, and about 400 different species of birds. Dinner and a night in a sleeping bag at Migunga.

Day3: Discovering Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, travel to Serengeti Fort Ikoma with a lunchbox and enjoy game drives in the Serengeti National Park together the way. Every kind of animal imaginable can be found in this enormous park, from big cats like lions, leopards, and cheetahs to the smaller herbivorous animals they victim on. Then having Dinner and spending the night at a Serengeti place.

Day4: Visiting Serengeti National Park

You spend the entire day on a game drive in this National Park today, which is home to a wide variety of animal species. You will visit the Serengeti National Park for the entire day with a picnic lunch in hand to optimise your chances of seeing wildlife. Dinner and spending the night at a Serengeti lodge.

Day5: Travelling to Karatu

After breakfast, continue your Tanzania Safari Tour by driving to your lodge, which is located in Karatu, just outside the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Massive herds of buffalo, antelope, and wildebeest exist in the caldera, which is home to the threatened black rhino as well as prides of lion, elephant, and cheetah. The caldera is more than 300 square kilometres in dimensions. Visit the Oldupai Gorge, the location of the popular archaeological finds made by Louis and Mary Leakey, in the way. Among their discoveries are some of the earliest known ancestors remains of the man. Get to the place in time for lunch. After dinner and spending the night at Bougainvillaea Safari Lodge, the afternoon is free.

Day6: A Trip to Ngorongoro Conservation Area

For a day-long crater tour, you are going to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area today and go down more than 600 metres to the crater floor. Discover the areas within the lake where you could find flamingos, the open savannah where lions hunt, and the forest where monkeys and elephants exist. Lunches for picnics will be offered in the crater. Return in the late afternoon by vehicle to Bougainvillaea Safari Lodge for a meal and accommodation.

Day7: From Karatu to Arusha

You will be driven to Arusha after breakfast. Here you will spend the day relaxing after your days of adventure, or exploring and learning a little bit more about the culture on your own.

Day8: Fly Back Home

Before being taken to Kilimanjaro airport for your flight home, enjoy your last breakfast in Arusha.
