Itinerary

Day1: Arrival Nairobi

At Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, a staff member will greet you and assist with your transfer to Nairobi Serena. The elegant Nairobi Serena Hotel, recognised for its exceptional efficiency, service, and five-star hospitality, is a member of "The Leading Hotels of the World" and was awarded "Africa's Leading Green Hotel" and "Kenya's Leading Business Hotel" in the 2016 World Travel Awards. Named for its central Nairobi location, the Nairobi Serena hotel lives up to its name, providing a tranquil sanctuary in the heart of one of Africa's most vibrant capital cities.

Day2: Exploring Amboseli National Park

Following breakfast today, your driver guide will pick you up and take you to the Amboseli National Park. Following lunch, head to the place at the base of Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest point, for a game viewing drive in the park. Amboseli is crowned by Mount Kilimanjaro, whose snow-capped reach their highest rises above a saucer of clouds. Regardless of its small size and delicate ecosystem, this park, which is only 150 square miles in dimensions, is home to over 400 species of birds and well over 50 larger species of animals. You will be taken back to your hotel for dinner and overnight later, once the sunset.

Day3: Continue exploring Amboseli National Park

Have fun on a game drive this morning. At 19,341 feet, the highest reach their highest in Africa, Mount Kilimanjaro, is the most amazing sight from Amboseli. You have the best chance of getting up close and personal with the magnificent elephant in the park. Along with other animals, you might see wild dogs, zebras, and Cape buffalo. Relax at your hotel during the hottest part of the day. In the afternoon, you will go on a game viewing drive. Every meal and the entire stay at the hotel.

Day4: A discovery day in Lake Elementaita

After breakfast, leave for Elementaita, making a lunch stop in Nairobi along the way. Proceed towards Elementaita and reach it by late afternoon. Take the remainder of the day off and relax. Dinner and the night before.

Day5: A day at Lake Nakuru National Park

You will spend the whole day doing game viewing drives at Lake Nakuru National Park, a superficial, acidic lake that is popular through the globe for having an enormous population of flamingos. Hundreds of thousands of these birds can sometimes give the lake a sparkling pink colour. Sarova Lion Hill Lodge is where we'll have lunch. You'll go on a game viewing drive in the afternoon.

Day6: A visit to Maasai Mara National Reserve

Kenya's most famous wildlife reserve, the Maasai Mara, is known for its broad range of animals, including the famous "big five." You will go on a game viewing drive after arriving at 1600 hours, after you will be taken to your camp for a meal along with a rest. Millions of wildebeest, zebras, and gazelles live in the reserve. They migrate there from the Serengeti plains in Tanzania in late June, spanning the Mara river and Tanzanian border to reach the Maasai Mara grazing fields. The reserve is home to an extensive variety of birds, with records of nearly 402.2 species. It was the scene of "Out of Africa" shooting.

Day7: Safari Trip in Maasai Mara

A sunrise game drive, a late brunch, a late afternoon game drive, and a nightly stay at Mara Serena Safari Lodge are all included in the itinerary. Full board meals are provided by the camp, and balloon safaris are an optional extra. On your second or third day in MaasaiMara, you will take a one-hour flight over the national park to get a bird's-eye perspective of the wildlife. With miles of savannah, undulating hills, and riverine forest with grazing herds, birdlife, and one of Africa's largest lion populations, the reserve is one of Kenya's most beloved reserves. A delicious champagne breakfast in the wild awaits you after an hour of breathtaking views. You will be taken to your camp for a game drive after the flight.

Day8: Departure from Nairobi

As you depart for Nairobi after breakfast at the Camp, say goodbye to the Maasai Mara. Return to Nairobi by driving through the Great Rift Valley, passing by Lakes Elementaita and Naivasha, Mount Longonot, a dormant volcano. Head up the escarpment and look out for herds of gazelle and giraffe. Early in the afternoon, you will land in Nairobi, the vibrant capital of Kenya, from where you will be taken to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in time for your flight home. say goodbye to the amazing nation and make a commitment to come along on future adventures.
