Day 1: Arrival Day in Nairobi

Fascinating information about Maasai Marar

Kenya's most visited and well-known game reserve, Maasai Mara, is renowned for its wide variety of wildlife, which includes the Big Five. From late June to early July, the yearly migration of gazelles, zebras, and wildebeests from the Serengeti plains to Maasai Mara is a breathtaking sight. With over 450 different bird species in the reserve, Keekorok Lodge provides an ideal setting for seeing the yearly migration. Game drives and safari adventures are available from July to October.

Day 3: Exploration experience in Maasai Mara National Reserve

Spend the entire day taking morning and evening game drives in Maasai Mara. You can take advantage of the lodge's activities for the remainder of the day.

Day 4: Trip to Lake Nakuru National Park

This morning, start your journey by taking a drive to Lake Nakuru National Park, which is well-known for being a shallow, alkaline lake that is brilliantly pink due to the presence of large flamingo flocks. Numerous species of wildlife can be found in the park, such as the endangered Rothschild's giraffe, which is unique to this area, lions, buffalos, hippos, warthogs, baboons, and leopards relaxing in the yellow-barked acacia trees. In addition, both white and black rhinos find refuge there; the latter are particularly well protected.

Day 5: The final stop - Back to Nairobi

You will say goodbye to Lake Nakuru after breakfast and begin your journey back to Nairobi. Early in the afternoon, you will land in Nairobi, the vibrant capital of Kenya, from this point, you will be taken to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in time for your flight home.
