Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrival to Cairo and visiting Sakkara and Dahshur Pyramids

A Cairo Top Tours tour manager will welcome you upon your arrival at Cairo International Airport.

The first day of the tour will be devoted to sightseeing in Cairo, visiting the <u>Pyramids of Giza</u> and the Sphinx, where one of our expert Egyptology guides will provide an overview of the history behind the construction of these extraordinary edifications.

Then head to <u>Saqqara</u>, where you get to see the famous <u>Step Pyramid</u> built for King Djoser. After lunch, there is another excursion to the pyramids of Dahshur to view the Bent Pyramids and the <u>Red Pyramids</u> built for Sneferu, Cheops's father.

The final stop of the day will be <u>Memphis</u>, the first capital of Egypt, where you will see the massive statue of Ramses II and the alabaster Sphinx.

After a fun-filled day, your driver and tour guide will assist you with the check-in process at your hotel in Cairo.

Day 02 : Alexandria Day Tour

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, and then you will be under the care of a licensed tour guide and personal driver who will take you on a full-day tour of the city founded by Alexander the Great.

This will be your first stop, as you will head straight to the Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa.

Later, you will then visit the so-called Pompey's Pillar.

Afterward, you will proceed to the <u>Citadel of Qaitbey</u>, built in 1477 AD, where the Pharos Lighthouse once stood, after which you will be served a delicious, sumptuous seafood meal while gazing at the distant Mediterranean Sea.

Then head to the modern <u>Alexandria Library</u> and through the city's main squares, streets, and places of interest.

Your guide and driver will take you back to Cairo after stopping for coffee or tea. Return to the hotel in Cairo for another overnight stay.

Day 03: Cairo Tour

Following a satisfying breakfast in your hotel in Cairo, you will accompany your Egyptologist, who will take you to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, where you will get a chance to see the world's biggest collection of Egyptian antiques, including King Tut's coffins and golden masks.

You will spend roughly two hours in the museum before embarking on the tour of <u>Islamic Cairo</u>, starting with the renowned <u>Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque</u> and the Citadel of Saladin.

Following a sumptuous lunch, the journey proceeds to <u>Coptic Cairo</u> where you will explore the Hanging Church and the ancient Babylon Fortress.

You will also visit <u>Saint Sergius Church</u>, where the Holy Family was believed to have taken refuge. In Old Cairo's former Jewish quarter, a visit to the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u> will be made as well.

The trip concludes in Islamic Cairo, where you take a walk along the famous El Moez Ledin Ellah street, embellished with beautiful Islamic structures. Then proceed to the Khan El Khalili market, where you will have a taste of Turkish coffee or mango juice from the famous El Fishawy café.

Afterward, you will return to the hotel to end the day in Cairo.

Day 04 : Cairo to Luxor
