Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo and Check-in

Day 2: Cairo Tour

Day 4: Luxor West Bank and Edfu

Start your West Bank tour, which will take you past the Temple of Hatshepsut, the Valley of the Kings, and the Colossi of Memnon, after breakfast aboard the Nile cruise. As you float toward Edfu, savor lunch. Savor a buffet dinner in the evening, and then stay for musical acts and belly dancing. Luxor's historic buildings and the scenery surrounding the Nile River are breathtakingly visible from an optional hot air balloon flight. Take a nighttime sail along the Nile.

Day 5: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

As you cruise in the direction of Kom Ombo, breakfast will be served on board. See the <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, which honors the gods of crocodiles Sobek and Haroeris, and then the <u>Edfu Temple</u>. While sailing towards Aswan, guests will savor lunch on board. While you enjoy the Nubian Show, dinner will be served aboard the yacht. Stay the night in Aswan on board.

Day 6: Aswan Sightseeing

See the sights of Aswan, such as the <u>High Dam</u> and the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which was probably commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut, after breakfast aboard the boat. There will be dinner and an overnight stay on the ship.

Day 7: Disembarkation and Return to Cairo

You can choose to travel by road or by air in the early morning to see the amazing <u>Abu Simbel temples</u>, built by Ramses II. Before you disembark, have your last breakfast on the cruise. After your transfer to the <u>Aswan Airport</u>, you will take a flight back to Cairo and be dropped off at your hotel in Giza. Stay the night in Cairo.

After breakfast at the hotel, you may have some free time to enjoy additional Cairo tours. Later, check out from the hotel and transfer to Cairo International Airport for your final departure.
