Day 1: Cairo - Alamein - Siwa

Built during the 26th dynasty, this temple holds great historical significance, as it was believed to be the site where Alexander the Great consulted the oracles before his campaigns.

Next, you'll visit the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> at Um Ubeyda, a sacred site dedicated to the god Amun and his divine triad. Later, return to Siwa to visit <u>Dakrour Mountain</u>, a site of great cultural importance to the Siwan community. This mountain is central to the Tourism Festival of El Syaha, an annual event celebrated on the first full moon of October. The festival highlights the unity and traditions of the Siwan people, and it offers you an opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of their cultural heritage.
