Day 1: Cairo - Alamein - Siwa

Your adventure begins bright and early as our Cairo Top Tours professional guide picks you up from your hotel in Cairo at 6:00 AM for an unforgettable Egypt Desert Safari Tour to Siwa Oasis. Your first stop is [El Alamein](#), where you'll explore the World War II Cemeteries. These cemeteries are maintained by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission, honoring the soldiers and civilians from Commonwealth nations who sacrificed their lives during the war. You'll visit the battlefield and tour the World War Museum, gaining insight into this significant chapter of history.

Next, you'll head to the stunning coastal town of [Marsa Matrouh](#) on Egypt's north coast. Here, you can enjoy a fresh seafood lunch by the beach before continuing the journey to Siwa, approximately a six-hour drive from El Alamein. Upon arrival in Siwa, relax with a rejuvenating bath in a natural hot spring, then settle in for the night at a charming Eco-lodge, surrounded by the serenity of the desert.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

After breakfast, your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari continues with a visit to the ruins of the ancient town of Shali, a once-thriving fortress now partially melted by time. Next, you'll head to the [Temple of Alexander the Great](#), also known as the Temple of the Oracle, located in the ancient village of Aghurmi. This fascinating site dates back to the 26th Dynasty and played a significant role in history.

Your journey then takes you to the [Temple of Amun Ra](#) at Um Ubeyda, a structure dedicated to the triad of Amun. Step back in time at the [Siwa House Museum](#), where you'll discover the traditions and heritage of the Bedouin tribes of Siwa. Afterward, enjoy a delightful lunch at the beautiful Shali Fortress Square, with a meal at the charming Abdo Restaurant.

Later, relax with a refreshing swim at the famous [Cleopatra Spring](#) (Ein Guba), where the natural spring water has attracted visitors for centuries. End your day with a visit to Fitnas Island, where you'll witness a breathtaking sunset over the oasis.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

Start your day with breakfast at the eco-lodge before embarking on the [Great Sand Sea](#) tour. Your first stop is the rare archaeological site in Maraki village, located near the towering Siwa Mountain, where the first human footprint was discovered. As your safari continues, you'll journey into the heart of the Siwa Oasis dunes, arriving at the fossil area. Here, you'll witness the remarkable sight of seven fossilized coral reefs, dating back to the Cambrian age.

Next, explore one of the country's most fascinating natural wonders—the Great Sand Sea. In this breathtaking desert landscape, you'll encounter a beautiful, serene lake where you can see flamingos and, if you wish, take a refreshing dip in the cool waters. The tranquil setting offers a perfect escape from the world.

Afterward, unwind at the [Bir Wahid](#) hot spring, where the warm 40°C waters will soothe your muscles and leave you feeling rejuvenated. End your day with another stunning sunset over the Great Sand Sea, a sight that never fails to amaze you.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis Tour

Next, head to the Bedouin village of Abu Ali, where you'll get a glimpse of traditional Bedouin life. Visit the unique one-class school and discover fascinating aspects of their culture and daily life. While there, you'll also have the chance to explore the site believed to be the probable tomb of Alexander the Great, adding a touch of mystery to your journey.

Return to your hotel in Siwa for an overnight stay, reflecting on the rich history and cultural experiences of the day.
