Itinerary

Day 1: A visit to Luxor East Bank

Your 5-Day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan begins with a volley from your hostel in Luxor. Our representative will transfer you to the voyage boat, where you will be given the keys to your cabin. After a short break, you will enjoy your first lunch mess on board the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise. You will also meet your English-speaking Egyptologist companion in the lobby to begin your Luxor East Bank tenures. Luxor, located 700 kilometers south of Cairo, is a megacity of around 500,000 people who calculate heavily on tourism and farming. Your first stop will be the magnificent Karnak Temple, the largest tabernacle in Egypt, which was erected and expanded over 2,000 times, from a simple sanctum during the New Kingdom to the huge complex at its moment. Next, you will visit the emotional Luxor Temple, located in the megacity that bears its name and was discovered in 1884, on the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor. After your Luxor excursions, you will return to the voyage boat for a late stay, ready to continue your program hereafter. You can also attend the Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple as a voluntary exertion. reflections included for the day are lunch and Dinner.

Day 2: Discovery Tour to Luxor West Bank

Day 3: A Tour to Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

One of the highlights of your <u>Egypt Day Tours</u> will be the visit to the <u>Temple of Horus</u> in Edfu. This temple, which is one of the largest in Egypt and exceptionally well-preserved, retains all the elements of an ancient Egyptian temple.
