Itinéraire

Day1: Hola From Madrid

After landing at Madrid's airport, make your way to your hotel. The rest of the day is free.

Day2: A Discovery Tour in Madrid

After breakfast at the hotel, the day starts with a guided city tour of Madrid that takes in the Plaza Mayor, Plaza de la Villa, Hapsburgs Region, and Barrio de la Morería. During the tour, you'll get to see famous sites like Puerta de Alcalá, the Cibeles and Neptuno Fountains, and the Royal Palace. The tour also takes in the attractions and sounds of present-day Madrid, such as the Santiago Bernabéu Football Stadium, Gran Vía, Castellana, Salamanca district, and business districts. You can explore more in the afternoon.

Day3: A Tour between Madrid, Caceres, and Cordoba

First Have your breakfast at the Hotel. Drive to Caceres, Which is bound for Andalusian soils and is recognized as a World Heritage site due to its unique blend of Italian Renaissance, Roman, Islamic, and Northern Gothic architectural styles. Take a stroll through the Old Town, Which features the renowned Mediaeval Quarter, And Plaza Mayor. We keep moving towards Cordoba, Which was formerly the Caliphate's capital.

Day4: From Cordoba to Seville

First Have your breakfast at the Hotel. Take an amazing tour of Cordoba's Mosque (entrance included) and other locations that will lift our spirits while meandering through the Jewish Quarter's winding, tiny streets. Continue your journey towards Seville in the afternoon.

Day5: A Day Tour in Seville

First Have your breakfast at Hotel breakfast. Tour of Seville, the capital of Andalusia, in the morning. See the Cathedral, which is the second-largest in the world after St. Peter's in Rome for Catholics. Proceed to the Santa Cruz neighborhood, where you will find Carmen's natural setting and the myth of Don Juan. After that, proceed to Maria Luisa Park and Plaza de España. You have the afternoon to yourself to explore the city of lights.

Day6: A Tour Between Seville, Ronda, and Costa Del Sol

Initially After breakfast at the hotel, we'll drive south on the road through typical Andalusian villages until we reach Ronda. Take some time to take in the stunning views of the surrounding mountains and valleys, as well as the town's Celtic heritage. Our next stop is LA Organic, the hometown of Almamazara, for a genuine olive oil experience. Explore their olive groves and sample their organic olive oil, which is made in-house. Finally, we'll head to Costa del Sol, which is Spain's coast and is situated along the stunning Mediterranean.

Day7: Moving From Costa Del Sol to Granada

After enjoying breakfast Meal each day at the hotel, travel to Granada, one of our favourite Spanish gems. We will visit the renowned Alhambra complex (entry included) and Generalife Gardens, with its magnificent monumental setting. Following some free time, get together with other travellers to enjoy dinner and the most genuine Gipsy Flamenco show.

Day8: A Visit to Granada, Toledo, and Madrid

Have your breakfast at the hotel. Heading towards the magnificent Imperial city of Toledo, a World Heritage Site where the Christian, Moorish, and Jewish cultures lived together for generations. Take a guided city tour through the winding streets of this historic old town. Then Keep going to Madrid.

Day9: Adios From Madrid And Hi From Cairo

Have a delectable breakfast at the hotel, and head to the Madrid airport for your transfer. Then Greetings from the fascinating nation of Egypt, the home of the Pharaohs for countless centuries. Your assigned tour manager will be ready to welcome you at [Cairo International Airport](#) and help you manage your entry visa. After that, you'll be driven through Cairo's crowded streets in a cozy and air-conditioned car. When you get to your chosen hotel, like the Le Riad Luxury Boutique Hotel in [Khan El Khalili](#) or the Hilton Pyramids Golf Hotel with a view of the [Great Pyramids of Giza](#), your tour manager will help you with check-in and go over the schedule to confirm all the scheduled pick-up times for your activities during your trip

Day10: Exploring the Pyramids and Cairo City

After a delicious and massive breakfast at your hotel, your guide will take you to the Giza Plateau to begin your journey with awe at one of the Seven Wonders of the World, the [Great Pyramids of Giza](#). You can walk or ride a camel to reach [the Valley Temple](#) and [the famous Sphinx](#). After you tour the pyramids, you will have lunch at a traditional Egyptian restaurant and then [visit the Egyptian Museum](#), which is situated in the heart of the historic district of Downtown Cairo and provides views of [Tahrir Square](#). After admiring the exquisite ancient Egyptian relics and treasures, you will be driven through [Old Cairo](#) to the historic Islamic neighborhood of Cairo. You will be able to do so there and explore the lively, winding, and treasure-filled lanes of [Khan El Khalili](#), Cairo's oldest bazaar.

Day 11: Fly to Luxor to visit the East Bank Sightseeing

You are going to depart from Cairo today and travel to the gorgeous city of Luxor. Your tour guide will pick you up at your hotel early in the morning and drive you to [Cairo International Airport](#) so you can fly to Luxor. When you arrive in Luxor, you will be welcomed and driven to your luxurious Nile cruise, Salacia, in a premium air-conditioned car. Salacia will provide you with first-rate service, fine dining, and lodging during your Nile cruise. After a delectable meal on board, make your way to the East Bank to see [the Karnak](#) and Luxor temples at your first stop in Upper Egypt. When you get back to your cruise, enjoy a hot, freshly prepared dinner.

Day 12: A Visit to the West Bank

Experience your first meal while on board your cruise, taking in the peaceful panorama of the Nile. Move to explore Luxor's West Bank after breakfast. See [the Valley of the Kings](#), home to the Royal Cemetery of 62 Pharaohs, and then head [to the Queen Hatshepsut Mortuary Temple](#), constructed at [Deir El-Bahari](#) by the New Kingdom's architects in the fifteenth century BCE. As the day comes to an end, take in the majestic [Colossi of Memnon](#). Once your time at the West Bank is up, head back to your cruise ship and begin your journey to [Edfu](#) while enjoying a delectable lunch on board. Take advantage of your cruise's fantastic amenities, relax for the remainder of the day as you sail, and enjoy some afternoon tea. get a massage and de-stress in the Jacuzzi. End the day with an appetizing dinner on board.

Day 13: Explore Edfu and Kom Ombo

You'll start your cruise with a delectable breakfast and sail to [Edfu](#). One of the best-preserved Greco-Roman temples, [Edfu Temple](#), will be visited, and you'll get a taste of rural Upper Egypt with a horse-drawn carriage ride. You will travel through gorgeous landscapes filled with date and banana palm trees. Following your visit to the temple, you will set sail for [Kom Ombo](#), where you will visit the town's unique temple, which has two entrances, hypostyle halls, and sanctuaries, as well as explore the town. You'll return to your cruise ship after a delectable lunch to enjoy a warm dinner beside the Nile River.

Day 14: Aswan Sightseeing

Sail to the vibrant city of Aswan while you enjoy another delicious breakfast on board. After arriving, spend a day sightseeing in this lovely city and getting to know the most friendly locals. Visit the enormous [Unfinished Obelisk](#), which is still lying on its side in the ancient Egyptian stone quarries. You will next proceed to the stunning [Temple of Philae](#), which honors the two goddesses Hathor and Isis. Following your visits, you'll return to your cruise ship and enjoy a delectable dinner while admiring the stunning waters of the Nile.

Day 15: Fly to Cairo with an Optional Tour to Abu Simbel

Enjoy a final delicious breakfast on board while cruising your final morning in the calm waters of the Nile. Once breakfast is served, disembark from the ship and head to the [Aswan Airport](#) to catch your flight back to Cairo. Once there, you'll be greeted and taken to your hotel for your final night in the Land of Pharaohs.
