Day2: Explore Samburu National Reserve

Start your Kenya safari package to the Samburu National Reserve on your second day after enjoying a tasty breakfast. You'll arrive in time for lunch at your wonderful lodge, the Samburu Intrepids, and spend the evening taking a game viewing drive before returning to your lodge for dinner.

Day3: Continue exploring Samburu National Reserve

Famous over a wide range of wildlife, including the Grevy's zebra, Somali ostrich, circulated giraffe, gerenuk, and Beisa oryx, also referred to as the Samburu Special Five, you will have an extra day to explore everything that Samburu provides. A minimum of 900 elephants are present in the reserve. Mammalian predators like cheetahs, leopards, and lions are major draws.

Day4: A Trip to Pejeta Conservancy

On your fourth day, depart for the Pejeta Conservancy, which offers views of Mount Kenya. This majestic giant creates a magical atmosphere by casting shadows across the landscape. You will drive in search of the Big Five, explore the waterholes, and visit the chimpanzee reserves while you are there. Even though you're on a safari, you can still live in luxury; Sweetwaters Tented Camp has everything you need for a comfortable overnight stay.

Day5: A visit to Lake Nakuru National Park

Your journey continues to Lake Nakuru National Park on the fifth day. This shallow, alkaline lake is well known around the world for its assortment of birds, which gives the lake a pinkish hue from a distance. The magnificent Acacia trees surrounding the lake can be seen surrounded by hippos, buffalo, waterbucks, giraffes, and other wildlife. You will spend the night at Flamingo Hill Tented Camp, which is furnished with natural woods, wrought iron accents, soothing safari colours, and crisp linens. Every tent in the camp has been carefully planned to maximise comfort.

Day6: an exploration day at The Maasai Mara National Park
